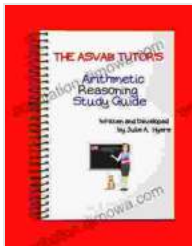

- B.  $x =$  the unknown score.  $(93 + 89 + 96 + 98 + x) \div 5 = 95$  or  $(476 + x) \div 5 = 95$ . Now solve for  $x$ .

A waitress earns an average of 12% of the cost of the food she serves. If she serves \$375 worth of food in one evening, how much money in tips will she earn on average?

- B. Multiply the amount spent on drinks, \$375, by 12% (or 0.12) to determine the amount of tips.
